On April 19, 2021, after submitting a grant written through the non-profit Upstate Workforce Futures Corporation (UWFC) to the Women Giving of Spartanburg for the fourth straight year to get a muchneeded van to transport the ACHIEVE students, ACHIEVE received this email:

"I am pleased to inform you, on behalf of Women Giving for Spartanburg, that ACHIEVE will receive a Grant in the amount of \$27,295 towards the achievement of the goals and objectives set forth in your Grant request submitted to Women Giving (WG) for Spartanburg. This selection from an initial Grant application pool of twenty-five and ten finalists, carefully considered by the entire membership of Women Giving, attests to our belief in your ability to make a true difference.
