#### Staff Development

- Cherokee, Union and Spartanburg Adult Ed Presentations are taking place monthly.
- Staff are completing cyber security training from USC Upstate.

Shortly into October, two of our fast-track graduates Dylan Coleman and Davon Pettis enrolled in ACHIEVE at the Spartanburg Center. They jumped right into class work and within a short amount of time Dylan received his GED still in October with Davon not far behind him receiving his GED in November. Both guys received a \$150 incentive and asked about a work-based learning experience. The guys both were interested in the mission field, but also knew there were many aspects. We were able to pair them with the Prodigal Home in Union, who provides mission and safety to men in recovery. Dylan and Davon work on all aspects, to include general facility

maintenance and upkeep of the working farm to provide resources. Both graduates have expressed continuing in the mission field and find this work experience very helpful.
