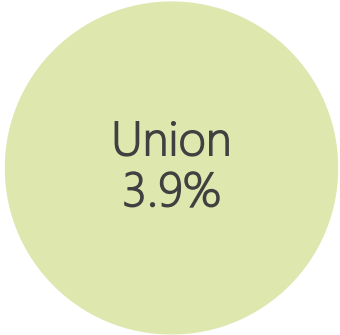

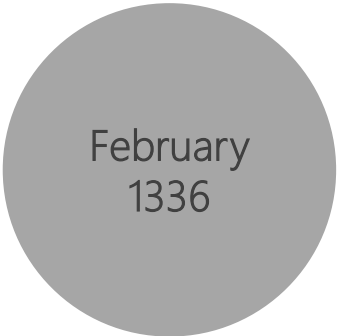

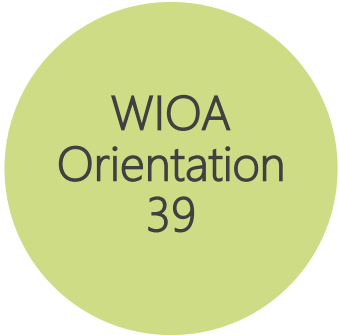
## Unemployment Rates

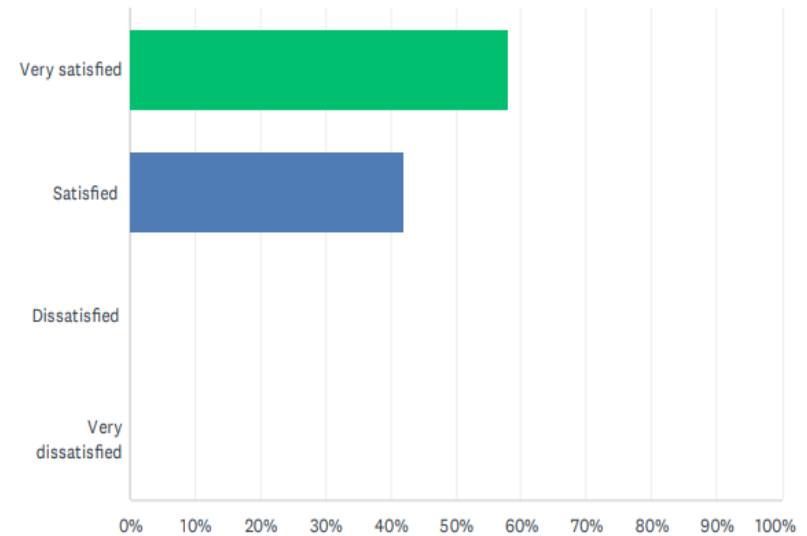

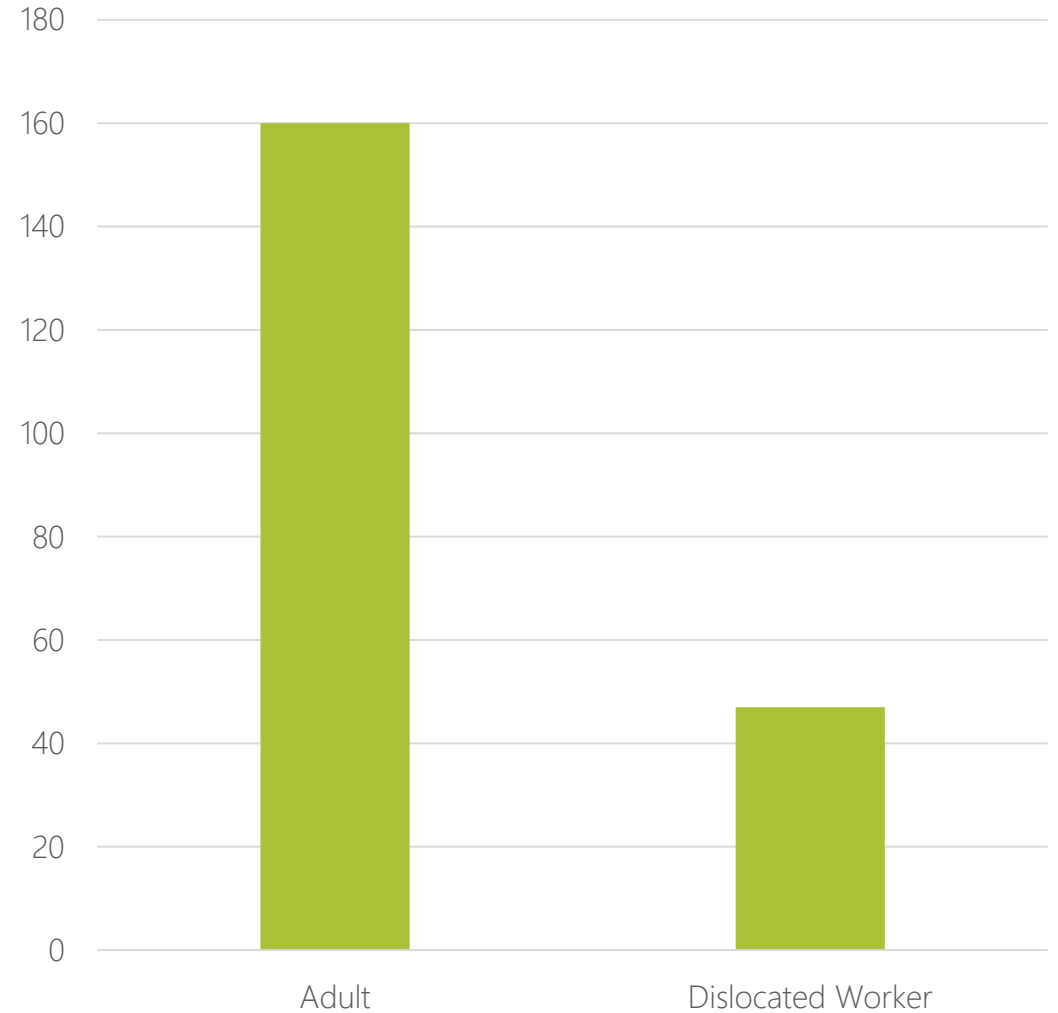

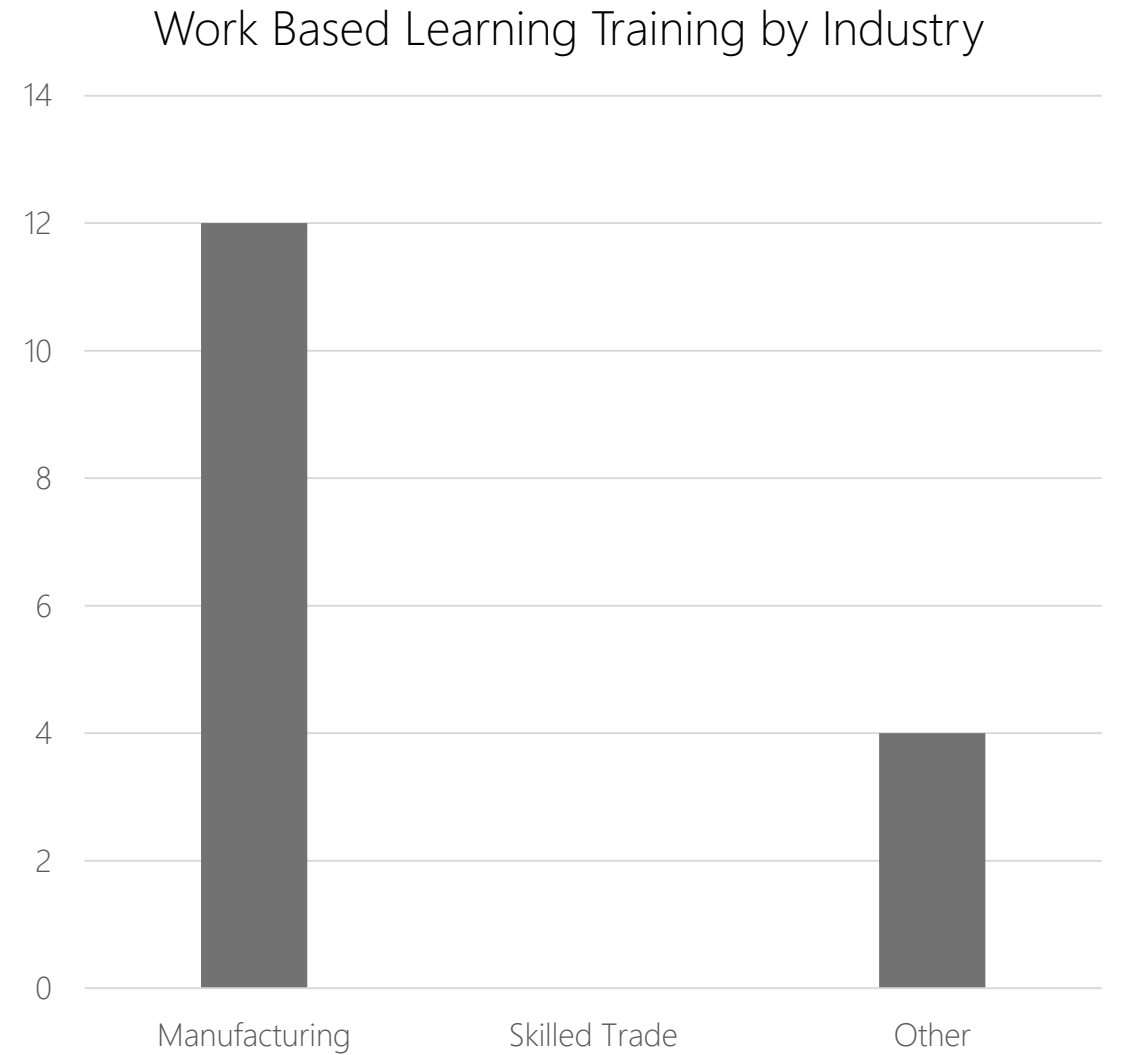


# Funding Stream Progress & Industry Percentages
