






# Funding Stream Progress & Industry Percentages



### Success Story

Ms. Miller was employed part time as an Esthetician at the Brow Bar, and although she enjoyed the job, it wasn't generating enough income to care for her family. She had a strong interest in completing truck driver training with the barrier of no financial support to achieve this goal. She checked with several organizations and was turned away from a partner due to lack of funding, which led her to SC Works for training and supportive services.

Ms. Miller successfully completed CDL training at Commercial Driving Academy in 2023 and obtained a CDL certification. She showed a constant sense of responsibility, commitment, and a desire to improve during her participation in the WIOA program. Right now Ms. Miller has received employment with Bottom Leay LLC, and has been driving with them since. Naranda states, "she felt very lucky to be able to find a driving position so quick out of training, but is very thankful for the opportunity."

Ms. Miller informed without the assistance and help from the WIOA program that it would have been impossible for her to have this opportunity.
