ACHIEVE Students Attend College Day Event

Through a partnership with Cherokee County Adult Education, the ACHIEVE career specialist, Lisa Hannon, organized a College Day event in December that included three students that are concurrently enrolled with Adult Education and the ACHIEVE Program. A Spartanburg Community College (SCC) admissions representative visited the Cherokee County Adult Ed and conducted sessions to include completing the SCC application and completing the SCC entrance assessment.



During the Covid ordeal, ACHIEVE students continue to be transported to class and attend classes under the SC Works Center Covid guidelines.

Van drivers make extra trips to transport students. ACHIEVE has two sessions: morning session (9:00am-12:00pm) and afternoon session (1:30pm-4:00pm). The two sessions allow fewer students per class to practice physical distancing. Most students are able to attend at least three days/week. Additionally, the Spartanburg County Adult Ed liaison that works at the ACHIEVE site conducts online sessions for those who prefer to work online and to allow more instruction time out of class.
