- Staff received SCWOS training.

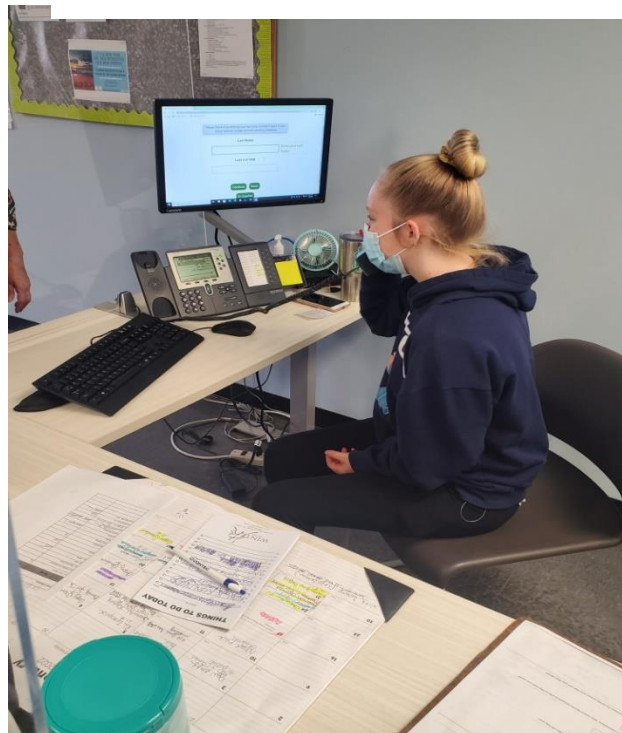
OUTREACH
