Cherokee 911: Providing Job Mentorship

As the new contract year begins, the first work experience began in July. Natalie White enrolled with ACHIEVE in April 2021 and received her diploma with Cherokee County Adult Ed in June 2021. She received intensive career guidance with ACHIEVE's career readiness specialist, Lisa Hannon, who writes about the details of Natalie's work experience in her career interest field:

"Natalie White successfully completed a paid work experience with Cherokee County E911 Communications. This work experience provided Natalie with information about the Cherokee County Emergency Management System and its daily operations. Her duties included: listening to emergency calls, taking notes during these calls, and entering these notes into the computer system. In addition, she observed the dispatchers call in the correct personnel from multiple agencies based on the call and the emergency at hand. She heard the dispatchers communicate first aid to the callers for different situations. The E911 supervisors provided valuable training information that prepared her a career as an EMT. Natalie enjoyed her work experience this summer. She is looking forward to beginning her EMT classes at Spartanburg Community College this fall."
