Just In Time Report

ACHIEVE Begins Modified On-site Classes

On June 1, 2020, ACHIEVE began on-site classes for participants to attend class on a modified schedule. ACHIEVE has closely worked with SC Works to ensure that all COVID guidelines are adhered to. Participants have adapted well, wearing masks and keeping physical distance. Participants attend morning and afternoon classes to accommodate more participants while practicing physical distancing. Participants attend on average twice weekly instead of every day and work on study packets and online during their distance learning days. The instructors are readily available as they have been during all of COVID to assist with lessons. The process has gone smoother than any staff thought. It is not ideal for participant learning, but it is the best situation possible at present.

Participants who need transportation continue to be transported. Each staff and the two van drivers have given early morning time to pick up participants with one participant per van, sitting at the back and both driver and participant wearing masks. Participants enter through the front and have temperature taken with the nocontact digital thermometer, just as SC customers do.

Since participants returned, there have been four to obtain their GED diploma, thanks to our partnership with Spartanburg Ad Ed who accommodated our participants for testing.

ACHIEVE will continue to assess the learning process and work with SC Works for the best possible safe learning environment.
