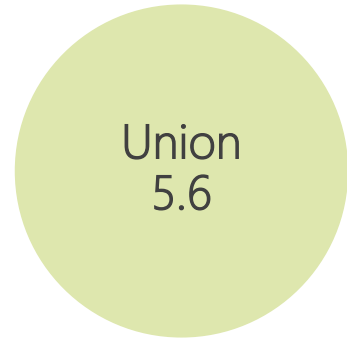
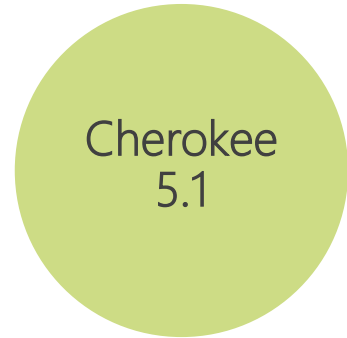

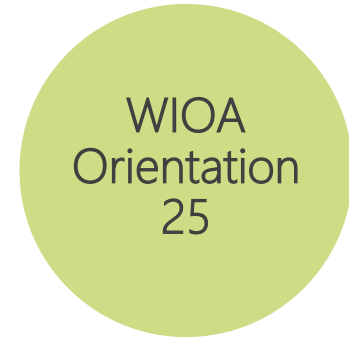
Unemployment Rates

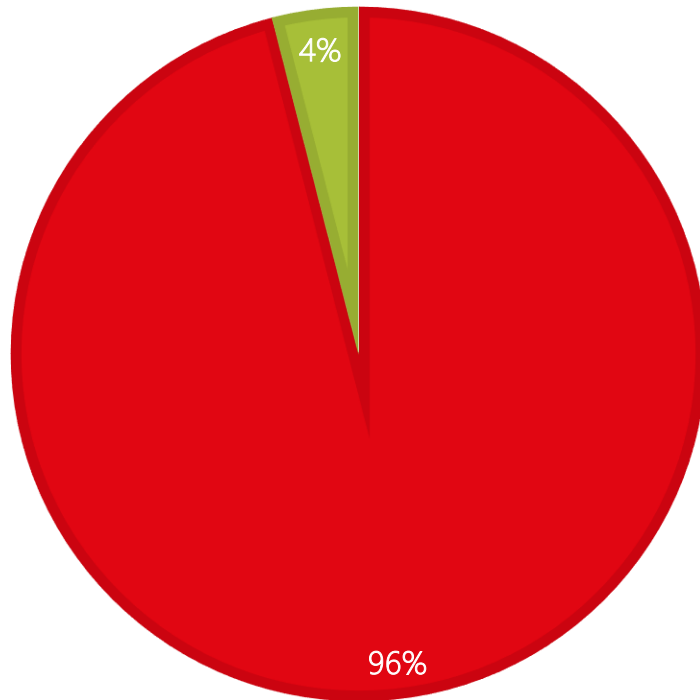

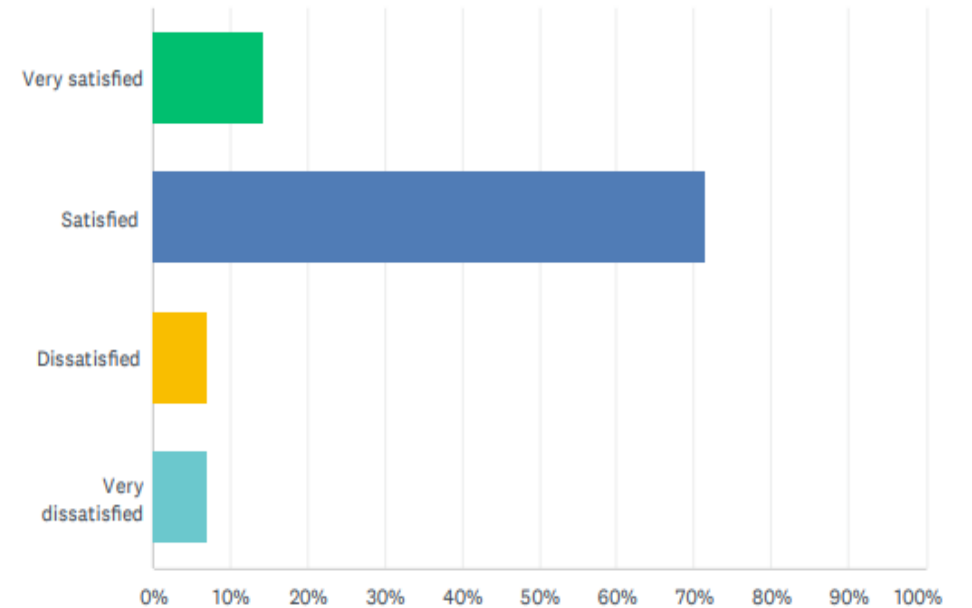

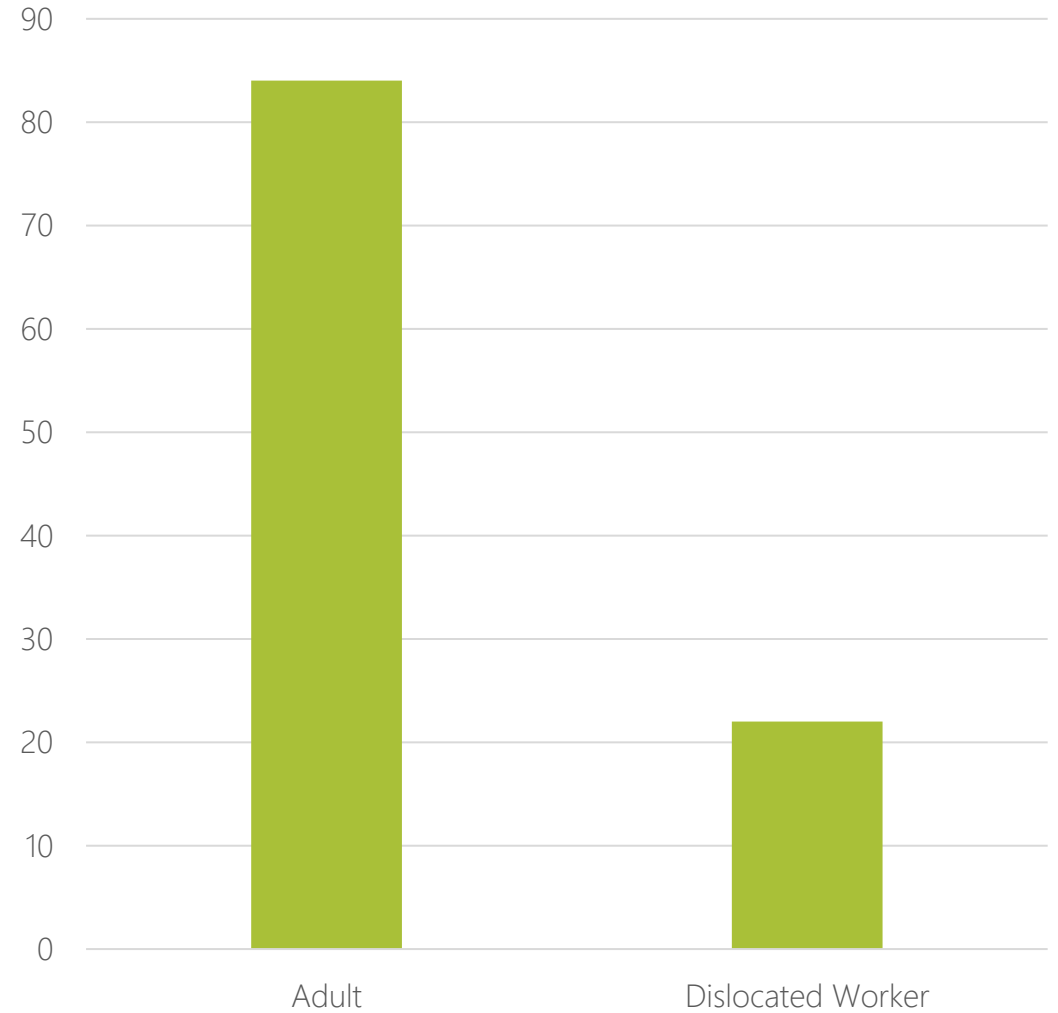

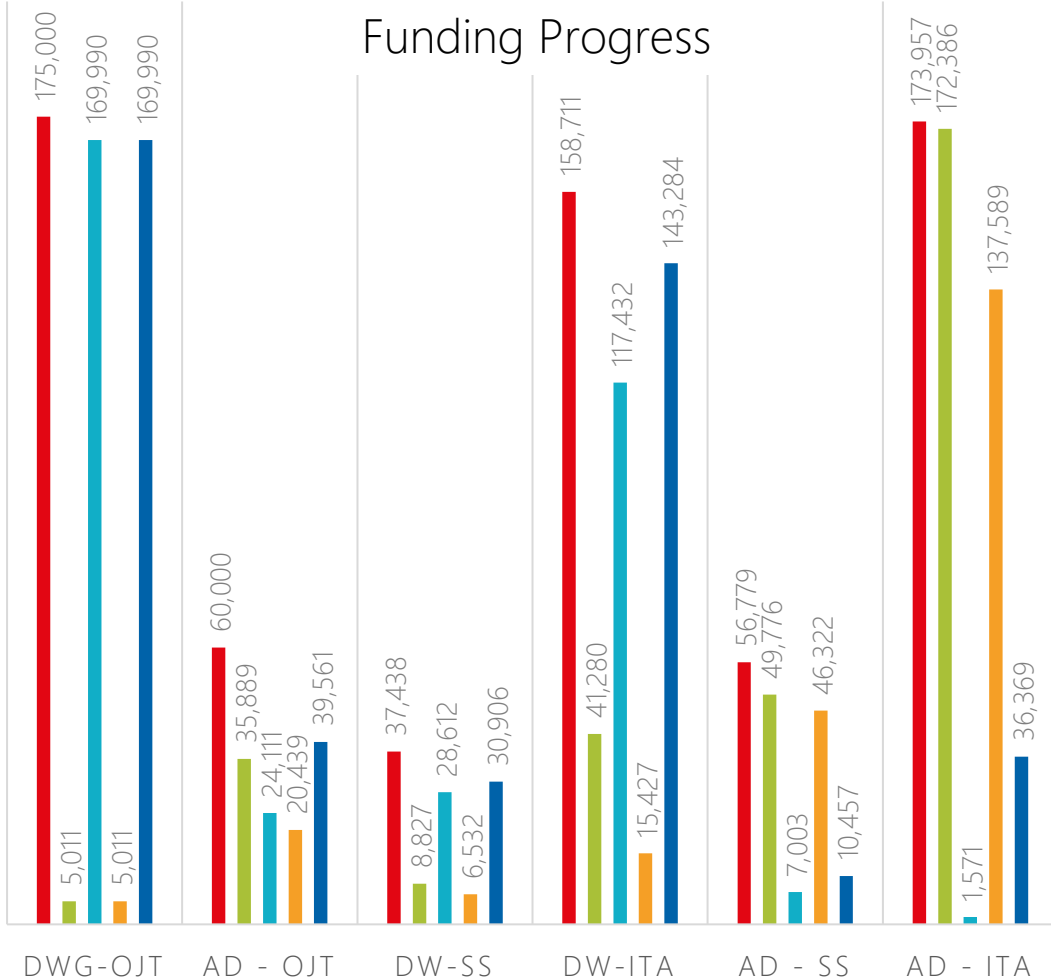

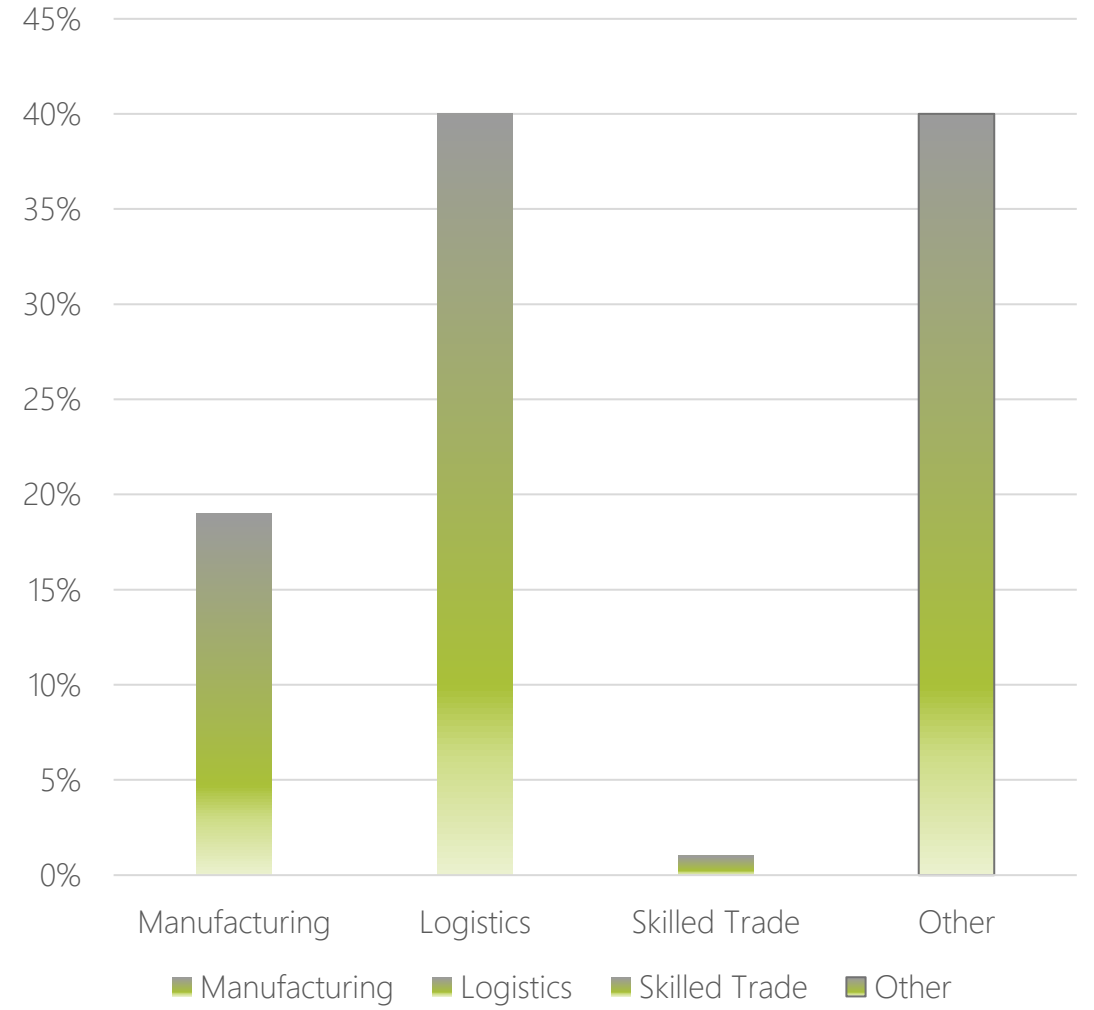


Funding Stream Progress & Industry Percentages

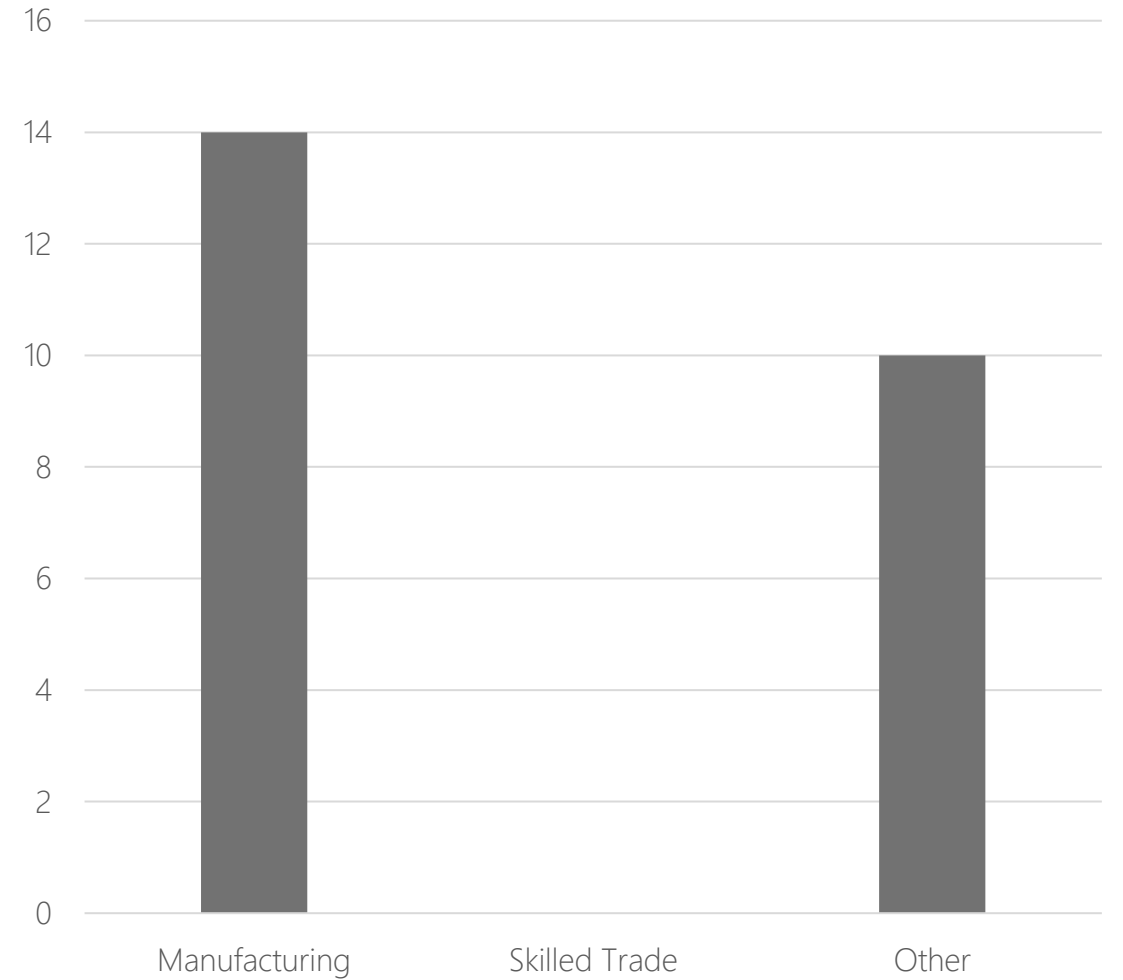

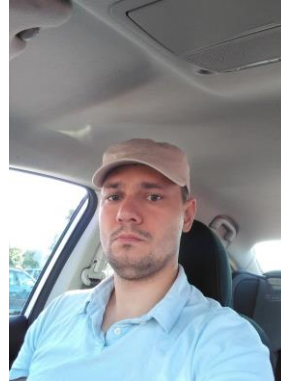

Success Story

Mr. Pavel Mazur came to SC Works as a driver for Door Dash and Grub Hub. He shared that he had a growing family which his income at the time could not sustain. He was very interested in obtaining his CDL for a new career path, but truck driver training was expensive. He checked several sources that could help with his career goals, which led him to SC Works for training and supportive services.

Pavel was enrolled in the WIOA program on July 7, 2022. He entered the program in search of a career path in the trucking industry to have financial stability and growth.

"Occasionally I heard about SC WORKS. I came to their office late June and in early July, I started my CDL classes so quickly, unbelievable." Pavel worked closely with the Talent Development Specialist (TDS) to identify barriers, prioritize needs, and strategize a way to move forward. Mr. Mazur completed the TABE testing. He also completed a Scholarship Application and supporting documents. He applied to the Commercial Driving Academy and got accepted into the CDL-A program. Mr. Mazur was enrolled for the CDL program on July 11, 2022, at Commercial Driving Academy located in Duncan, SC. Mr. Mazur was approved for tuition cost and support services for transportation to the Commercial Driving academy.

Mr. Mazur successfully completed CDL training at Commercial Driving Academy on August 9, 2022 and obtained a CDL certification. Mr. Mazur showed a constant sense of responsibility, commitment, and a desire to improve during his participation in the WIOA program. Right now, Pavel is looking for a job. "My preference is a local position. If I was open for any position, my income will be double or even triple if compared with what I have right now. I really appreciate SC WORKS for their help!"
