Welcome

The meeting was called to order at 12:33 p.m. by Mr. Craig Jacobs, Committee Chair.

IWT Review

Ms. Dana Wood reminded the committee that they had recently allocated \$75,000 of local funding to support IWT. The state also issued an additional grant for IWT in the amount of \$38,734.00. A total of \$113,734 is currently available. The most recent solicitation resulted in \$246,887.36 in requests from 16 companies located in Cherokee, Spartanburg, and Union counties. The committee held discussion and provided scoring and funding recommendations for each application received. Based on scores and available funds, the OneStop Committee recommends IWT funding for the companies listed below. It is important to note that the committee distributed funding to all 3 counties in our local workforce area.

OneStop Operator and Adult/Dislocated Worker Provider

Mr. Craig Jacobs, reminded the committee of the RFP review committee process and that local approval is required. The RFP Review Committee was charged with scoring the proposal and providing a recommendation to each OneStop Committee. The Review Committee met on March 28th and voted to approve ResCare Workforce Services as the Operator and Adult and Dislocated Service Provider for Cherokee, Greenville, Spartanburg and Union counties. **Ms. Martha Young made a motion to approve ResCare Workforce Services as the Operator and Adult/Dislocated Worker Service provider for all 4 counties. Mr. Shelley Blount seconded the motion. The motion carried with no abstentions.**

ResCare Budget Modification

Ms. Dana Wood presented Budget Modification #2 for ResCare. She highlighted that the modification resulted in no overall change to the grant amount. The modification included line item shifts only.

Summary:

- Decrease of \$2,000 in supplies
- Decrease of \$2,000 in telephones
- Increase of \$1,000 in rent
- Increase of \$2,000 in out-of-town travel
- Increase of \$1,000 in the relocation
- Decrease of \$39,473.68 in supportive services
- Increase of \$39,473.68 in training

Mr. Jeff Gossett made a motion to approve the Budget Modification as written. Mr. Shelley Blount seconded the motion. It was approved unanimously.
