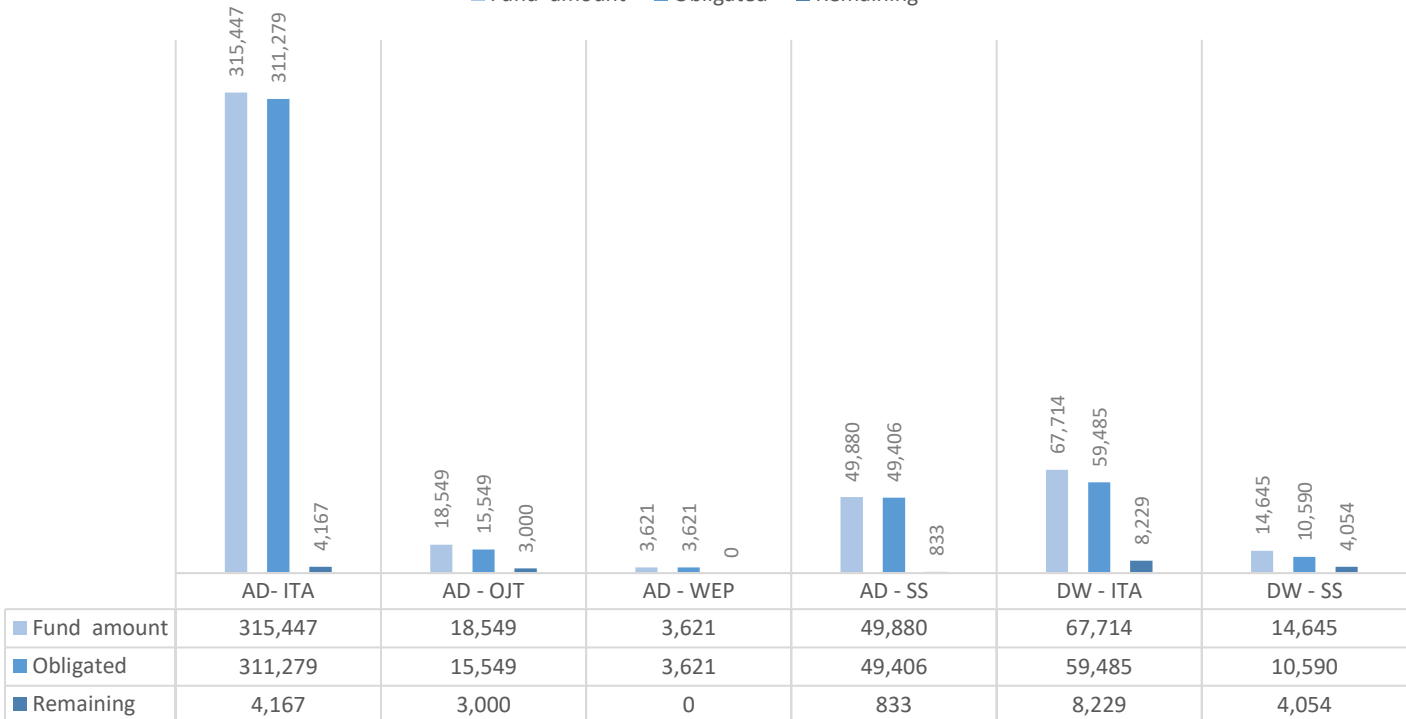

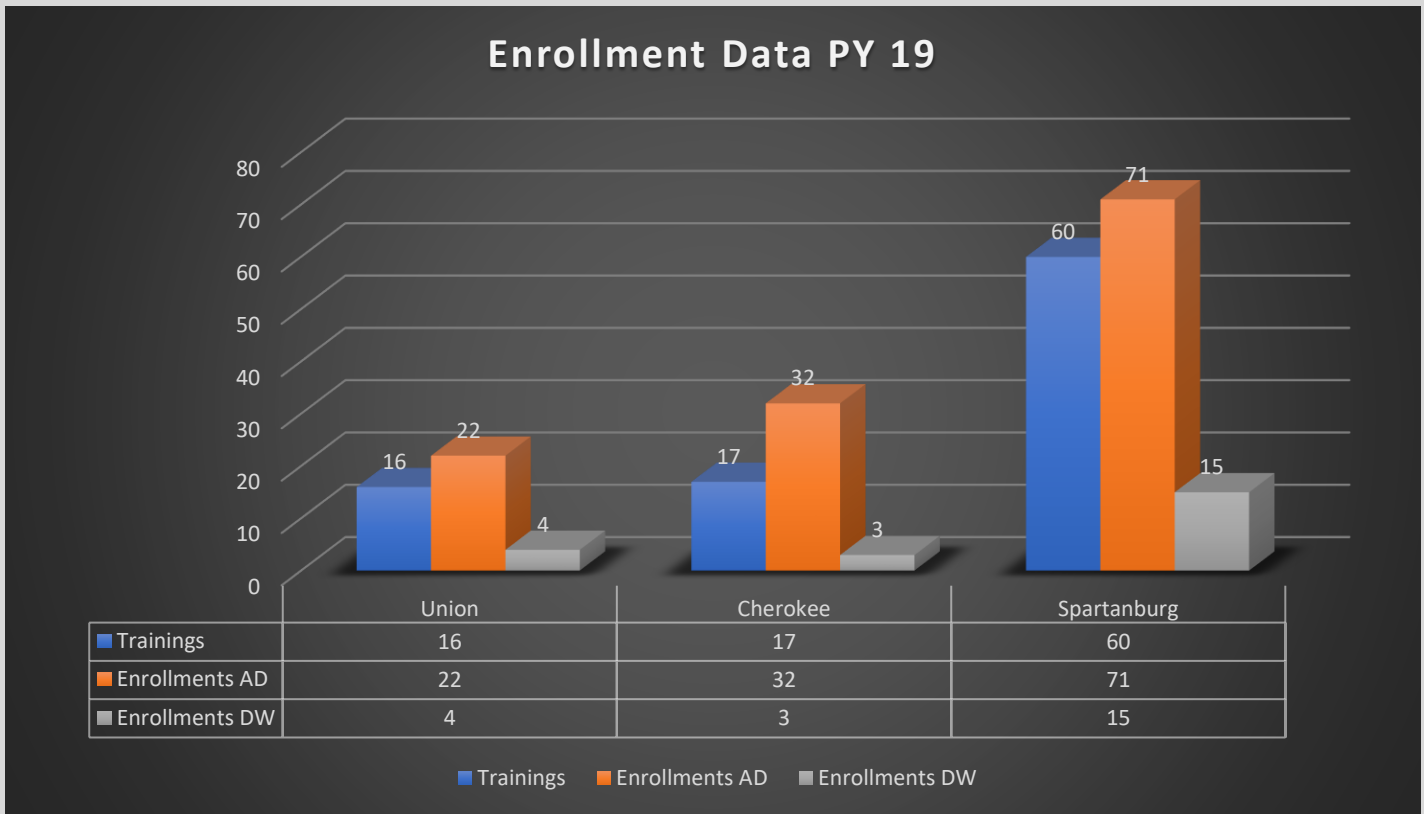

Level funding for the program is more likely for FY 21, unless somehow it makes it into the Phase IV COVID Bill (but we don't have any inside information on what that will look like yet). We wouldn't anticipate 2020 changes this late in the fiscal year.*
- *Nikki participated in a conference call in which the SCC Mentor Group was developed in partnership with the SCC Apprentice Committee. The Mentor group is currently developing an innovative course and outline for an Employability Skills Course at the local level.*
