

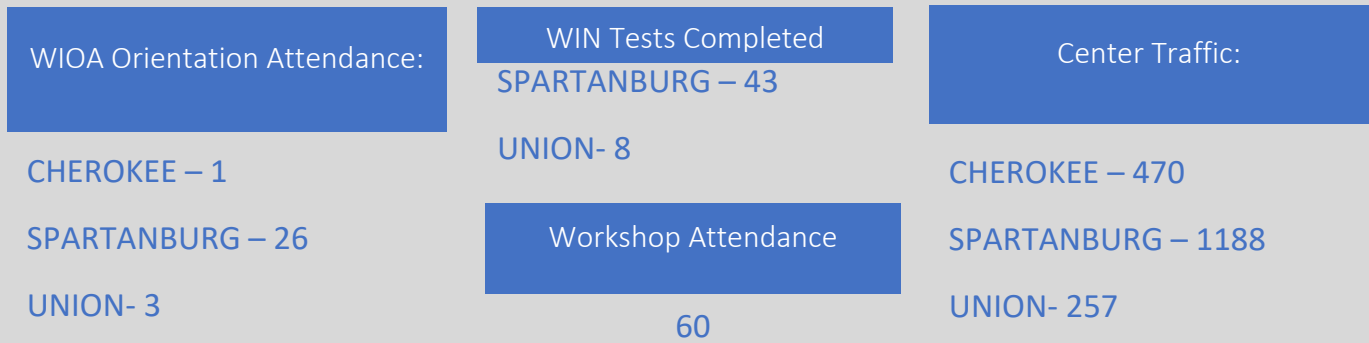

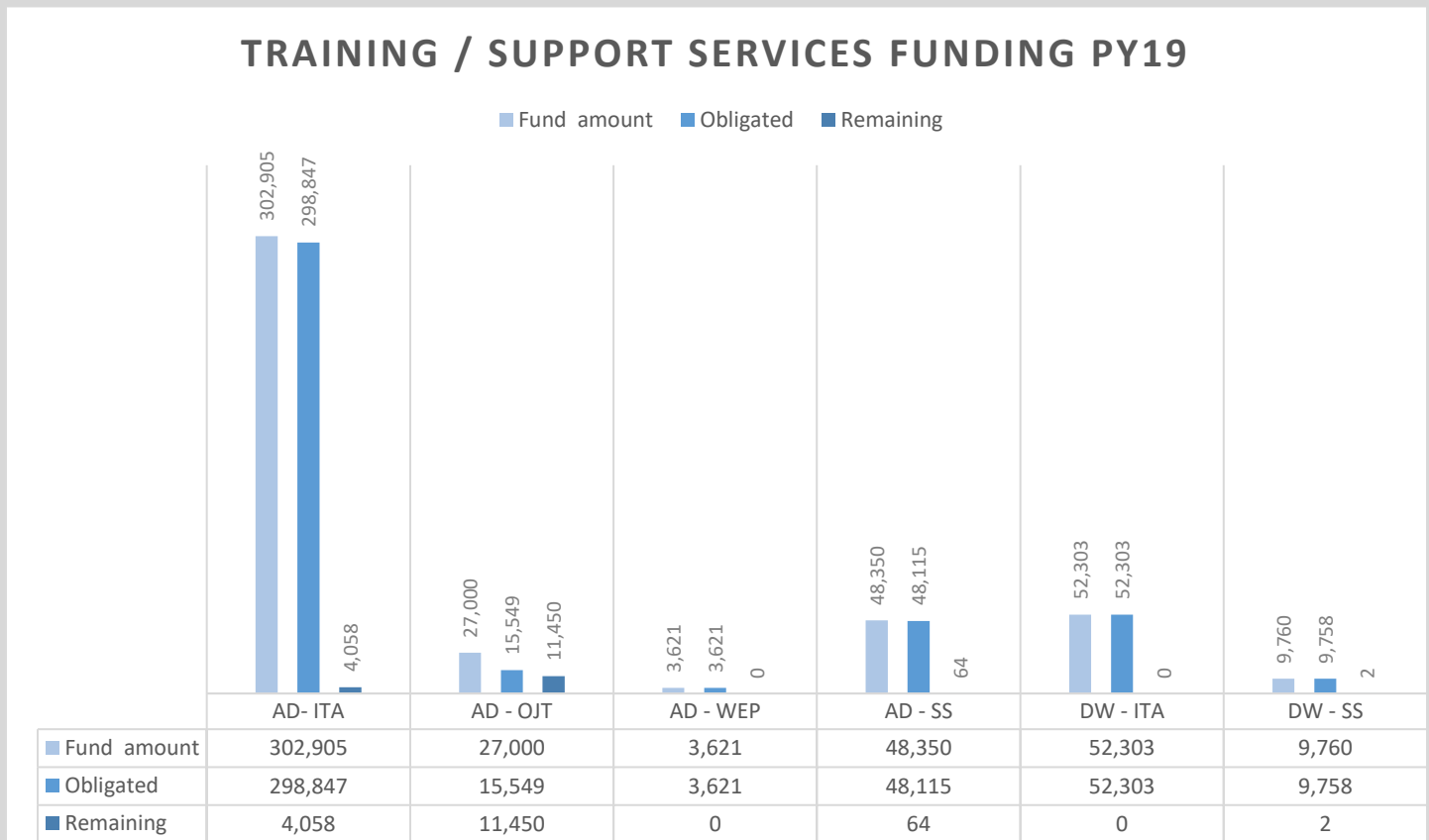
SC Works Upstate Traffic, WIOA Orientation, WIN, and Workshop Data Since Last J.I.T.



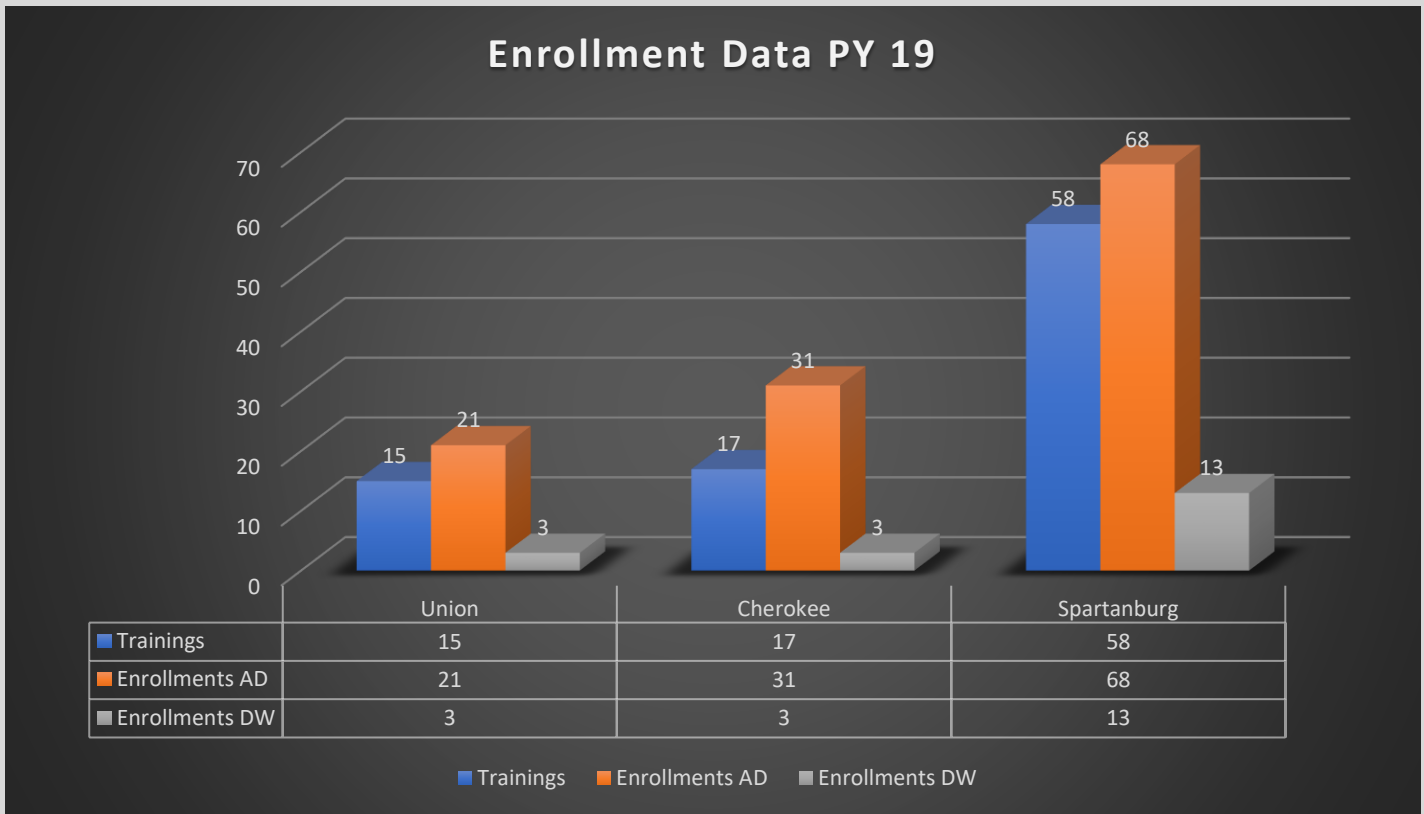

Business Services Focus

- Benjamin and Johnnie-Lynn attended a meeting with the Cherokee County Development Board, Upstate Workforce Board and SC Commerce to plan a Job Fair for High School seniors of Cherokee County.
- Ben and Nikki attended the Apprenticeship Workshop planning lunch meeting hosted by SCC. The group discussed the need for youth and adult apprenticeships in the local area. The group is working on a strategic plan to create awareness in the subject; in addition, the group is also planning an Apprenticeship Workshop in the near future.
