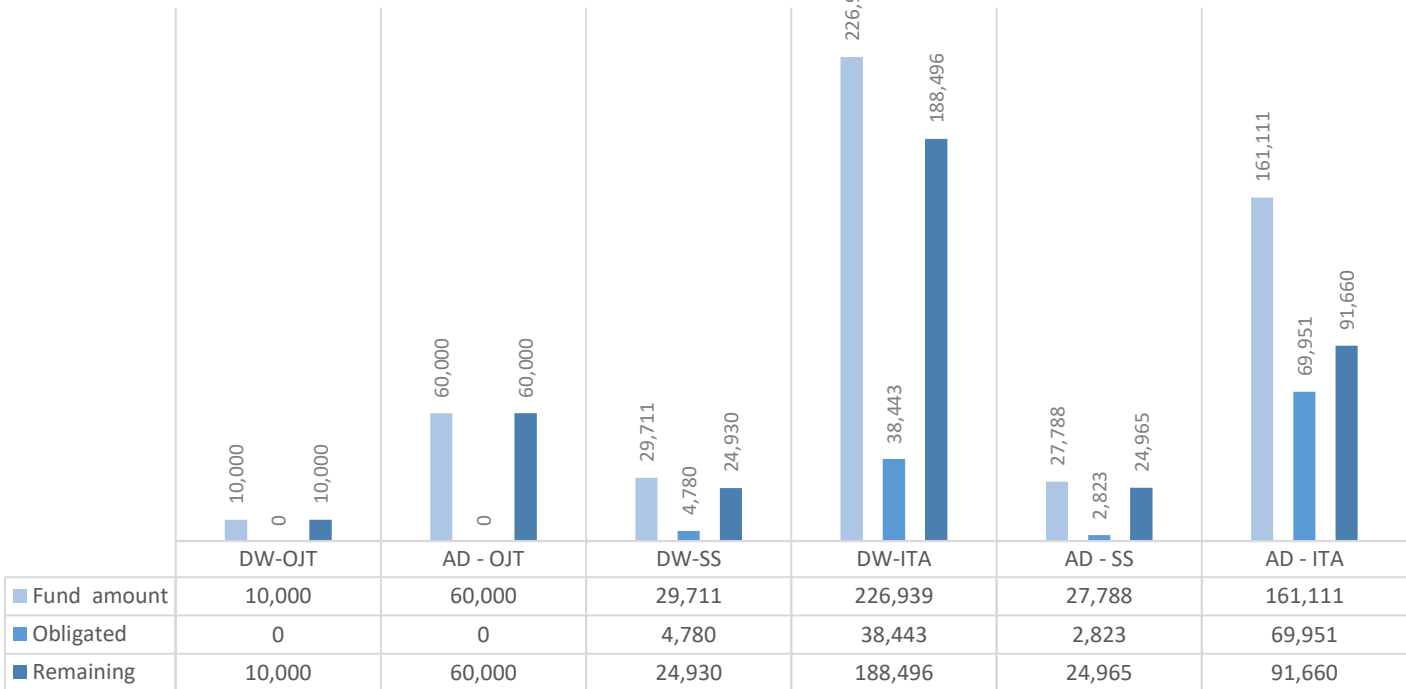

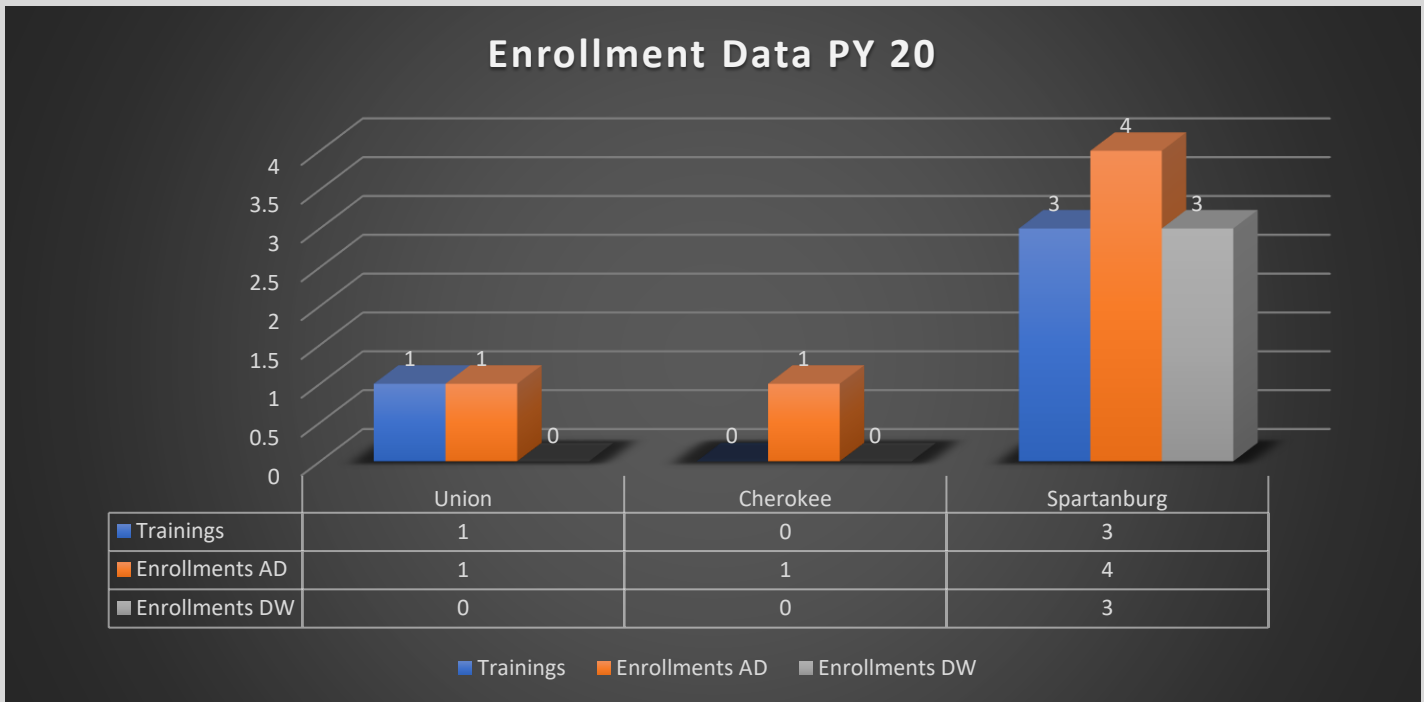

Business Services Focus / Outreach

Kenneth attended a Zoom meeting with both staff and clients of Vocational Rehabilitation to present information on constructing a Resume.

RDBS attended virtual meeting with 4 Greater Upstate Workforce Boards and Upstate Alliance regarding potential EDA grant opportunities.

RDBS attended virtual meeting led by Credential engine regarding opportunities for provider transparency and early college data sharing.

RDBS facilitated quick report BST meeting to include Equus and SCDEW staff members. Planning for Food/Retail and Professional virtual events was discussed.

Kenneth was invited to join Ann Angermeier and attend a Zoom Meeting with the Citizen Scholars program to discuss Soft Skills and how they relate to the workplace. There were 50 students on the session.

Devis participated in a Spartanburg Housing Authority Victoria Gardens resident event. During the event, COVID-19 tests were being provided to the community among other services. Individuals could receive information on WIOA / SC Works services and be pre-screened for potential employment with area contractors.

Devis participated in Spartanburg Housing Authority Power Hour. Power Hour is an online meeting open to the Spartanburg Housing Authority residents where agencies speak about their services and how they can help the community. Devis spoke about all services offered at SC Works Upstate including Partner services. There were 7 individuals in attendance.

Project Director participated in two Ten at The Top (TATT) "TATT Chat's". One had Jeff Brown, Greenville Drive, providing an update on the organization coping with the Covid-19 crisis impacts; the next chat featured Sara Hazzard, CEO, SC Manufacturers Alliance, providing similar updates. Both sessions had representatives providing local county updates in the 'Ten' region of Upstate.
